PARTY CHAPTERS TAKE LEAD IN IMPROVING DISTRIBUTION

[Text] In keeping with the resolution passed by the Standing Committee of the Hanoi Municipal Party Committee on accelerating the three revolutionary movements within the capital, the party chapters within the grain sector have launched a political activities drive designed to improve the organization of distribution and the management of grain and reduce the bother caused the people.

Practically all of the party chapters at the grain bureaus and stores have had their cadres and party members study the resolution of the 7th Municipal Party Organization Congress, the specifics of the three revolutionary movements and the four major jobs of the municipal party committee between now and the end of 1977. On this basis, the party chapters have reviewed their shortcomings in the distribution and management of grain and adopted measures designed to improve the overall leadership ability of the party organization and the exemplary role played by party members. All party cells have engaged in criticism and self-criticism with regard to their shortcomings in the distribution of grain and the loopholes in management, especially misappropriation, authoritarianism and a lack of the spirit of responsibility; they have set forth clear guidelines and measures for correcting negative phenomena. The six party chapters of the grain stores in Hai Ba Trung Ward have unanimously agreed to send products to the precincts and rely upon the people to have them distributed.

The party chapters and committees of the grain bureaus have put a number of additional party members on the sales force in an effort to insure that each store has a party cell or party chapter which is capable of leading the performance of the political task, putting the activities of the party cell and party chapter on a regular basis and improving these activities along the lines of concentrating on successfully carrying out the political task, namely, insuring fair, reasonable, democratic and convenient distribution. The party chapters have routinely inspected the work of party members and taken steps to help each party member; they have strengthened and improved the

activities of the Youth Union and Trade Union in the management and distribution of grain, etc. The various party committee echelons have assigned persons the task of observing and maintaining close contact with the basic level and keeping abreast of the improvement of the distribution of grain. The party committee of the Hai Ba Trung Ward Grain Bureau has guided the various stores within the ward in studying the experience gained by Quynh Loi in how to distribute grain to the people in a convenient manner. Many grain bureau and grain store leadership cadres have gone to each precinct, agency and enterprise to obtain the opinions of cadres, workers and the people concerning the organization of distribution; on this basis, they have developed new forms of distribution suited to the aspirations of the people. Today, practically all of the grain stores in the four urban wards distribute grain by the following method: sales personnel go to each neighborhood team, take the team's order, collect payment for the order and issue a receipt; the people then go to the sales counter to pick up their orders. Many cadres and party members at stores have set good examples in conducting patrols and standing guard to protect granaries, picking up and delivering orders to neighborhood teams and providing them with receipts, all of which they do after work hours.
