This replies to your letters, concerning the report of Naval Research and Development Unit, Vietnam, serial 0134 of 27 May 1970.

We have searched our collection of Vietnam period records including the files of Commander Naval Forces, Vietnam and Inshore Warfare division materials. I must report that we were unable to locate the Final Report on Project 104-68, Waterdog. I am, however, enclosing extracts from the command history of NRDU-V which offers a resume of facts connected with this project. There is a possibility that the report of interest may be included among a collection of reports and studies concerning the U.S. Military in Vietnam which are held by the National Technical Information Service, 5285 Port Royal Road, Springfield, VA 22161, and you also may want to contact that organization directly.
