COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of August the average monthly strength in the III MAF Detention Facility was 41. The average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 289. Med Caps were held in the hamlet of Thach Nham, and the total attendance for the month was 385. Medications and immunizations were given to the ill. Armed Forces Police continued to fulfill its mission of providing Law Enforcement in Danang, RVN, and security for I Corps Advisory Facilities during the month of August. Additional emphasis was placed on the apprehension of UA's in Son Cha village in cooperation with NSA Security, Phoenix Committee and the 5th C.I.T. The Combined Narcotics Team conducted 4 operations which resulted in the arrest of 8 Vietnamese Nationals, and the seizure of 3 kilos of bulk marijuana, 910 marijuana cigarettes and 30 grams of opium. The accident rate for the month of August remained high, with 126 reported accidents. The fatality rate was also considerably higher than in previous months. Cpl J.W. Cpl REALI, 2423345, Cpl PECK, 2259535, and Cpl DOMMEL, 2395247 received their injuries in defense of 3d MPBn cantonment, while LOpl OHARA, 2453912, Cpl BELLOWS, 2464740, and Sgt HARVEY, 2289614 received their injuries while serving in the capacity of either a Scout or Sentry Dog Handler attached to USMC units throughout I Corps.
