COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of September the average monthly strength in the III MAF Brig was 216. The average monthly strength in the III MAF Detention Facility was 38. Med Caps were held in the hamlet of Thach Nham, and the total attendance for the month was 521. Medication and immunizations were given to the ill, and the newly initiated weekly Dent Cap treated 52 children. Armed Forces Police continued to fulfill its mission of providing Law Enforcement in Danang, RVN, and security for I Corps Advisory Facilities during the month of September. The accident rate for the month of September remained high, with 153 reported accidents, but the fatality rate was decreased considerably to 4 as compared to 12 for the month of August. The Combined Narcotics Team conducted 8 operations which resulted in 13 arrests and the seizure of 1980 marijuana cigarettes and 37 grams of opium. Sgt P.S. SEGUNDO, 2296766, died (Non-Hostile), Quang Nam Province, RVN, 5 September 1969. On the morning of 6 September 1969 the 3d Military Police Battalion cantonment came under an enemy mortar attack, receiving approximately 100 82mm mortar rounds, inflicting 2 friendly KIA's and 42 friendly WIA's (See Part III for Listing of Personnel). KIMBRO, 2469825, WIA, Quang Nam Province, RVN, 20 September 1969. LCpl G. C. YORTY, 2431145, WIA, Quang Nam Province, RVN, 25 September 1969. All of the above, received their injuries while serving in the capacity of either a Scout or Sentry Dog Handler attached to USMC units throughout the I Corps.
