COMMANDER'S NARRATIVE SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

During the month of July the average monthly population of the III MAF Correctional Center was 208. Med Caps were provided twice a week in the Hamlets of Thach Nham and Nghi An. Total attendance for the month of July was 450. Medications and immunizations were given to the ill and the Dent Cap treated 22 patients. Augmentation of the Armed Forces Police, Danang continued and Company D continued to provide security for the American Consulate. From 1 through 31 July 1970, the Blackmarket Team conducted Ten (10) operations which resulted in twelve (12) apprehensions. Most of the apprehensions were a direct result of abuse of Exchange privileges. The value of government property recovered was \$472.10. From the period of 1 through 31 July 1970, the I Corps Combined Narcotic Team conducted Ten (10) operations, resulting in the confiscation of three thousand twenty-nine (3,029) marijuana cigarettes, two (2) kilos of bulk marijuana, three (3) grams of solid opium, three (3) bottles of obesitol, and two (2) containers of amesol with twenty (20) tablets each. The ten (10) operations also resulted in the arrest of nineteen (19) Vietnamese Nationals. On 2 July 1970, Security Platoon was transferred from H&S Company 3d M.P. Bn., to D Company, 3d M.P. Bn.. On 10 July 1970, Lieutenant General K. B. MCCUTCHEON, Commanding General, III Marine Amphibious Force and Lieutenant General M. J. MCCANNREY, Commanding General USAFV toured the III MAF Correctional Center. On 16 July 1970, Dog Operations conducted a demonstration for the Sergeant Major of the Korean Marine Corps and his Staff. On 19 July 1970, the Mine and Booby Trap Dog Platoon conducted a demonstration for Sergeant Major DAILEY, Sergeant Major of the United States Marine Corps. On 23 July 1970, Dog Operations conducted a demonstration for Brigadier General LEE, Commanding General 2nd ROK Brigade.
