
Subject: Remedial training

1. Remedial training for students will be conducted at the appropriate training areas each Saturday of the cycle from 1300-1600.
2. Students required to attend will be the lowest standing man from each training squad. In some cases more or fewer than one man may be submitted by each principal instructor, depending upon the average level of performance. Nothing herein will limit the use of common sense in assigning students for remedial training.
3. Instructors for remedial training will be assigned by duty roster by each team chief. Any discrepancies between instructor roster and CQ roster will be handled by the Team Chief. The CQ duty will have priority.
4. Principle instructors will submit the names of students for remedial training on Thursday of each week to the Team Chief. Instructors will notify the individuals concerned as to time and place of instruction. The principle instructor will note on training record that student is receiving remedial training. The Team Chief will submit a roster to the Chief Instructor of students required to attend remedial training on Friday morning. Roster will contain the following information:

TIME
PLACE
INSTRUCTOR OR AI
Name of students to attend remedial training

The Team Chief will inform the class leader of platoon sergeant so they can make arrangements for transportation and chow.
5. During the first two weeks of training (Basic obedience phase), the students will report to the instructor at Bowling Bowl at 1300 hours with dog and all necessary equipment.
6. During the field training phase, students required to attend will report at the specified training site at 1300 hours with dog and necessary equipment.
7. Students required to attend remedial training will be transported to the bivouac area after noon chow at the Detachment mess hall in time for training. After remedial training they will be brought back to the Detachment.
8. Slow students who are trying their best should not be punished by taking their pass privilege. If a student is lazy or is riding Sick book or is a dispensary problem his pass privilege should be pulled. Team Chief should indicate on remedial training list personnel that should have no pass privilege.

9. Students required to attend remedial training will not be used in lieu of a duty roster weekend area guard detail.
