I just got your address and wanted to let you know how Cappy—DOO2 did in Viet Nam. Cappy was an outstanding dog in Scouting and indurance. I worked him for eight months and he was the best Scout dog I've ever seen and many others would agree.

Sir, at one time Cappy was credited with Sixty kills. Because Cappy was such a good dog no man on any mission, which Cappy was on. was lost to hostile fire or booby traps. I myself did not receive a wound and I credit this to Cappy one hundred percent.

I was out of service for 13 months and did not know your address or anyone who did, or I would have contacted you much sooner. I met SSG. Woodworth and he give me your address.

Sir, I want to thank you for the fine job you did with Cappy for, he is the reason I'm here today.

As bad as I hate to tell you this Cappy was put to sleep in March of this year for TCP.
