This is Bang . . .

A Montagnard hill-tribeswoman of the central highlands of Vietnam, Bang is one of thousands of critically ill patients treated each year at the Minh-Quy Hospital. When this picture was taken, Bang was convalescent: she had been acutely ill with meningitis complicated by muscle spasms and severe contractures.

While Bang fought her way back to health, her newborn infant was cared for by the Minh-Quy staff. Relatives who came with Bang to the Hospital were housed on the Minh-Quy grounds. Bang's own



care was supervised by skilled nurses, a few international, many, like her, Montagnard, with little or no formal education but with considerable nursing proficiency acquired on the job.

Without Minh-Quy and its resources -- the

doctors and nurses who watched Bang through the weeks of acute illness, the lab techs who monitored her disease, the kitchen staff who prepared her tube feedings, the physiotherapists who worked with her in the long months of recovery, the aides who mothered her child -- neither Bang nor the baby would have survived. Like so many Montagnards, Bang owes her life to Minh-Quy.
