Dear Lord Bishop,

With regard to your letter of June 29th. I regret to say that at the present time I am very hard up owing to a certain financial failure which may or may not resolve itself in the next six months or so. Be sure that I shall not forget you if I manage to recover anything from the debris.

In the meantime I have in my possession a Beck microscope, dated about 1938, with triple nosepiece, three objectives including 1/12 oil immersion and two eyepieces. It is in good condition and should be worth £20-30 on a good market such as London or some other University town like Cambridge. Alternatively it is quite capable of use as a diagnostic instrument for such diseases as amoebic dysentery or malaria if your medical people are short of such instruments. The choice is a matter for you.

If you are interested please let me know. I can easily arrange for its delivery in London.
