Phyllis writes from Laos — she too is not optimistic about returning to Kontum in the foreseeable future, and I get the general impression that the Vietnamese gov't is not putting out a welcoming mat for foreigners these days, even if they're medical & social workers brimming over with good will. Anyhow it's comforting to have the report that George Christian was in Kontum as of mid-June, and I would hope that this would include Edric too although he wasn't specifically mentioned. As for KHF's fund-raising activities in general, my own advice would still be to hang together and 'wait & see' — maybe we'll get an eyewitness report from George himself one of these days — ??
