Received your last note and always so pleased to hear from you and of any activity re: Vietnam. Every time the phone rings or the postman walks in I anticipate some news of George & Ed.

Have written to every one you have suggested & to be doubly sure I have a board member write back. All the answers are "No info" or no answer at all.

The 3 Montagnard families are here and Mr. Pat. has rented a large house where all will live. The church furnished it as I understand and it is just a couple blocks from school down town & church. They have also been offered jobs so it looks like all will be well for them after adjustment.

The board will keep the office open and accept funds for the hospital for a time yet.

I have written several letters to George & Ed 7. Red Cross, UNICEF, PRG Govt., etc. None have been returned but who knows if they were received.

Wash. State tells me that the Senior Red

Cross is definitely in Vietnam & they don't understand why there isn't some info. forthcoming from them but we get no answers!

Do you know anyone with Red Cross that we could or you could ask?

Seems so much time has elapsed that we ought to be able to get some word.

Thank you again for all the time & effort you have given to this cause. Certainly no one has done more.
