On the brighter side, Yol seems to be working well with the staff, but she told someone it side was a lot harder work than at Nha Trang. They are down to a pt. census of under 10 now. I guess the W woman dr. doesn't have much drawing power. An American dr. may be coming this month. Last I heard they still weren't sure about whether or not they'd be taking another nursing class.

A'Don, the Jh boy, that Dr. Baker made arrangements to have come here & work has really done well. He helps Pat in her clinic & does side work in the ward. He really shows initiative & sees things to do & goes ahead & does them. We want to send him to Nha Trang if they do take a class. Yet may be sent to Bro of St. John. Thanh just started the X-ray course in Saigon.

The house is really empty most of the time these days. Dr. Baker stays at the hosp. most of the time, Dr. Christian's gone, Scott's in Saigon this week, with 1 dr. + 1 nurse on duty at the hosp. sometimes there's only 2 or 3 around the house at night.
