PRG Officials 7/24 Meet Osaka Gov.

OSAKA — Two representatives of the Provisional Revolutionary Government (PRG) of South Vietnam Monday morning visited Gov. Ryotchi Kuroda of Osaka.

Ha Thanh Lam, leader of a two-member Viet Cong friendship mission, told Gov. Kuroda that hearty support of the Japanese people to South Vietnamese would be of great help in reconstructing their country.

Lam and another PRG representative Hong Ha were invited to visit Japan with two North Vietnamese earlier this month by the Japanese Committee for Support of the People of Vietnam and Japan Vietnam Friendship Association.

At the meeting, the PRG representatives presented Gov. Kuroda with a flower made from debris of the U.S. planes shot down over Vietnam.

The Osaka governor wished that people in Vietnam will succeed in establishing stable peace.
