

Huỳnh Tân

Charge d'Affaires of the [PRG of the] Republic of South Vietnam in Poland; on 17 January 1972 attended a rally held at a motor vehicle parts factory in Koszalin Province to denounce U.S. war crimes in Vietnam. (Nhan Dan, 24 Jan 72, p 4)

Huỳnh Tấn Mẫm

Acting president of the General Federation of Students; on 3 April 1970 a spokesman of the Saigon students held a press conference to denounce Huỳnh Tấn Mẫm's "illegal arrest and detention." (Nhan Dan, 5 Apr 70, p 4)

Huỳnh Thanh Mùng, Major

Vice chairman of the Tay Ninh Cao Dai Committee for the Consolidation of Peaceful Coexistence; was one of the chairmen at the National Congress of Delegates of South Vietnam held to elect a PRG. (Quan Doi Nhan Dan, 12 Jun 69, corrigenda, p 2)

Huỳnh Thanh Mùng, Maj, deceased

Was Commander in Chief of the entire unified army of the Cao Dai state; also vice chairman of the Committee for the Consolidation of Peaceful Coexistence of the Tay Ninh sect of the Cao Dai religion; also member of the Council of Advisers of the PRG; died 3 February 1970. (Nhan Dan, 18 Feb 70, p 4)

HUYNH THANH MUNG (see Huynh Van Mung) (Major)

Radio Lib. Sept 1964, listed him as vice chairman Comm. for Consolidation of Peaceful Coexistence (Cao Dai);

Also as commander of United National Forces, Cao Dai military units.

Radio Hanoi Feb 24 1970 said he died Feb 3 at age 54

Listed Cao Dai affiliation as Union of Cao Dai Believers in Vietnam
