Ambassador of the Republic of South Vietnam in Bulgaria; on 8 August 1969 was received by Bulgarian Vice Premier Zhivkov. (Nhan Dan, 11 Aug 69, p 4)

Huỳnh Phan

Ambassador of the Republic of South Vietnam to Bulgaria; was one of the officials who saw off an economic delegation from the DRV, headed by Le Thanh Nghi, on its departure from Bulgaria on 6 November 1969. (Nhan Dan, 9 Nov 69, p 1)

Huỳnh Phan

Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of South Vietnam in the People's Republic of Bulgaria; member of a delegation from the NLF and the PRG which on 23 October 1969 engaged in talks with a delegation from the government of Bulgaria, in Sofia. (Nhan Dan, 26 Oct 69, p 1)

Ambassador of the [PRG of the] Republic of South Vietnam to Bulgaria; on 21 December 1970 attended a rally held by the Bulgarian Ministry of National Defense in honor of the 26th anniversary of the Vietnam People's Army. (Nhan Dan, 29 Dec 70, p 4)

Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the [PRG of the] Republic of South Vietnam to Iraq; on 1 November 1971 presented his credentials to the President of Iraq. (Nhan Dan, 11 Nov 71, p 4)

Huỳnh Phan

Ambassador of the [PRG of the] Republic of South Vietnam to Iraq; on 20 September 1972 was received by Na'im Haddad, member of the Leadership Committee of the Socialist Arab Ba'ath Party and acting chairman of the Iraq Committee for Afro-Asian People's Solidarity. (Nhan Dan, 26 Sep 72, p 4)
