NGUYEN HUU THO DELEGATION VISITS QUANG NGAI PROVINCE 26 APR

[Text] Hanoi VNA April 27--A delegation of the Central Committee of the South Vietnam National Front for Liberation and the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam on April 26 visited the newly liberated province of Quang Ngai (the fourth below the 17th parallel), LPA reports today.

The delegation, led by lawyer Nguyen Huu Tho, president of the NPLSV Presidium and of the Advisory Council of the PRG, includes lawyer Trinh Dinh Thac, chairman of the Central Committee of the Vietnam Alliance of National, Democratic and Peace-Forces and vice-president of the Advisory Council of the PRG; Minister Nguyen Van Hieu, presidium member of the NPLSV; and Ho Xuan Son, secretary of the NPLSV Central Committee.

President Nguyen Huu Tho and his party visited the Thi Pho sugar mill, one of the biggest six sugar enterprises in South Vietnam. They also had contact with the people of all strata in the provisional capital of Quang Ngai.

On its way to visit Quang Ngai, the delegation called on Hoi An, capital of Quang Da Province, and Tam Ky, capital of Quang Nam Province.

[Text] On 24 April, a delegation of the NFLSV Central Committee and the PRGRSV headed by lawyer Nguyen Huu Tho, chairman of the NFLSV Central Committee and chairman of the PRGRSV Advisory Council, went to Danang by private plane for a visit.
