[Text] Hanoi VNA April 25--The delegation of the South Vietnam National Front for Liberation and the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam under President Nguyen Huu Tho yesterday called at a navy unit and an air-defence unit of the People's Liberation Armed Forces garrisoned in the city of Danang. According to GIA PHONG PRESS AGENCY (LPA), the delegation was accompanied by Ho Nghinh and Nguyen Chanh, chairman and vice chairman of the People's Revolutionary Committee in the city.

President Nguyen Huu Tho warmly commended the officers and men of the two units for their worthy contributions to the liberation and the defence of the province of Quang Nam and Danang city, and ordered them to do their best in reconstruction work and to observe strictly the 10-point code of conduct of the PLAP.

[Text] Hanoi VNA April 27--Over 60,000 people and combatants in the province of Quang Nam and Danang city on April 25 held a meeting in honour of the delegation of the National Front for Liberation and the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam led by President Nguyen Huu Tho, on a visit there, according to LIBERATION PRESS AGENCY (LPA).

Addressing the meeting, President Nguyen Huu Tho congratulated the armed forces and people in Danang city for having quickly brought life back to normal, maintained order and security and rehabilitated production and communications and transport and zealously built a new life in independence and freedom.

Dealing with the situation in South Vietnam, President Nguyen Huu Tho said: "Recently, the U.S. forced Nguyen Van Thieu to resign. This is another bitter setback of the U.S. policy of "Vietnamizing the war." He continued: "The new administration in Saigon is a Thieu administration without Thieu, aimed at carrying out U.S. neocolonialism in South Vietnam. The Ford-Kissinger administration can only choose one of these two ways: either to continue supplying additional weapons and munitions to the puppet clique in Saigon, spend more money of the American people and finally incur ignominious defeat, or to respond immediately to the two demands raised by the PRGRSV in its statement of March 21, to strictly implement the Paris agreement, and really respect the Vietnamese people's fundamental national rights and the South Vietnamese people's right to self-determination."

NGUYEN HUU THO DELEGATION VISITS DANANG 24-25 APR

[Text] On 24 April, a delegation of the NFLSV Central Committee and the PRGRSV headed by lawyer Nguyen Huu Tho, chairman of the NFLSV Central Committee and chairman of the PRGRSV Advisory Council, went to Danang by private plane for a visit. He was accompanied by lawyer Trinh Dinh Thao, chairman of the VANDPP Central Committee and vice chairman of the PRGRSV Advisory Council.
