Dr Ho Van Hue, vice minister of health, social action, and disabled soldiers of the Provisional Revolutionary Government of the Republic of South Vietnam, was born in 1917 in Long An to a patriotic Cao Dai family. he was graduated from the Hanoi School of Medicine. Before the August revolution, he actively participated in the anti-French and anti-Japanese movement of patriotic students. He enthusiastically contributed to the August 1945 general uprising. When the French colonialists returned to invade our country, he joined the army: He became head of the eastern Nam Bo military medical branch and was concurrently member of the eastern Nam Bo resistance administration committee. When the U.S. imperialists replaced the French colonialists and introduced troops to invade South Vietnam, he joined the PLAF as head of the military medical branch. Now, he is deputy director of the PLAF logistics directorate.
