MEMORIA SERVICE FOR PRG OFFICIAL HELD IN HANOI

Hanoi VNA International Service in English 1650 GMT 24 Feb 70 B

[Text] Hanoi VNA February 24--A memorial service was held here this evening by the special representation of the Republic of South Viet Nam in the D.R.V.N. for Major Huynh Thanh Mung, member of the Advisory Council of the R.S.V.N. P.R.G., who died on February 3, 1970 at the age of 54 in a liberated area of South Viet Nam.

The service was attended by Nguyen Van Chi, vice-chairman of the Reunification Committee of the D.R.V.N. National Assembly, Tran Huu Duyet, secretary general of the Viet Nam Fatherland Front Central Committee, representatives of Cao Dai believers in Hanoi, South Vietnamese co-provincial regroupees, and others.

Nguyen Thu Soai, acting head of the special representation, delivered a speech expressing deep sorrow for the demised.
