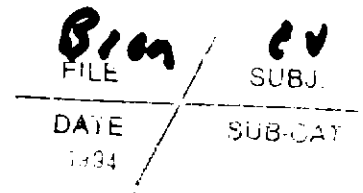

Work Experience:

July 1993-Present: Manager, Grants Section, California Environmental Protection Agency, Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB). Responsible for managing approximately \$20 million in grants, loans and contracts to over 200 local governments, businesses, and research agencies for recycling and proper disposal of used oil, waste tires and hazardous materials. Also coordinate Federal grants on environmental and economic efficiency. Feb. 1993-July 1993: Manager, Industrial Development Section. Plan and implement recycling market development zone and loan programs. Work with businesses and local governments.

Feb. 1991-Feb. 1993: Deputy Director, Office of Refugee Resettlement, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. Planned, allocated Federal funds (\$410 million annually), and managed refugee assistance programs nationwide. Worked with US State Dept., State governments, and community-base organizations. Served as keynote speaker on economic impacts of policy and programs in national conferences. Wrote papers on refugee adaptation.
