Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary to Australia; on 14-19 March 1984 he was present at meetings between Australian Government officials and Foreign Minister Nguyen Co Thach during the latter's visit to Australia. (NHAN DAN 21 Mar 84 p 1)

Ambassador of the SRV to Thailand; on 23 Mar 82 he visited Vietnamese military personnel who were being detained in Thailand. (NHAN DAN 29 Mar 82 p 8)

Hoàng Bảo Sơn

Head of Department 1 for Asia of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; on 24 May 1970 saw off the Mongolian Ambassador upon his departure for his own country. (Nhan Dan, 25 May 70, p 1)

Hoàng Bảo Sơn

Head of the Asia Department 1 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Was member of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam delegation that visited the People's Republic of Vietnam from 20 to 27 Nov 71. (Quan Doi Nhan Dan, 27 Nov 71, p 1)

Hoàng Bảo Sơn

Head of Department 1 for Asia of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; On 20 April 1972 he was present at the departure of a DRV military/government representation leaving for a visit to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (Quan Doi Nhan Dan. 21 Apr 72. p 1).

Hoàng Bảo Sơn

Chief of Asia Department 1 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; On 21 February 1973 he was present when the ambassador from the Democratic People's Republic of Korea presented his credentials to Nguyen Luong Bang, Vice-president of the DRV. (Hanoi Moi, 24 Feb 73, p 1)

Hoàng Bảo Sơn

\*Ambassador of the SRV to Thailand; on 6 Sep 78 he accompanied Premier Pham Van Dong on a visit to Thailand. (NHAN DAN 7 Sep 78 p 4)
