HOANG QUOC VIET VISITS SAIGON FACTORY 10 JUN

Saigon LPA in Vietnamese to VNA Hanoi 0317 GMT 11 Jun 76 OW--FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

[Text] Ho Chi Minh City (GPX, 11 June)--On the afternoon of 10 June 1976, Comrade Hoang Quoc Viet, member of the VWP Central Committee, president of the Vietnam General Federation of Trade Unions, and many other comrade members of the Vietnam General Federation of Trade Unions Executive Committee visited the Z.751 Quoc Phong factory in Ho Chi Minh City. [Saigon LPA in English to VNA Hanoi at 0331 GMT on 12 June identifies the Z.751 factory as a "national defense factory."]

Those "undecided" are numerous among the younger generation. For instance, in their 20's, they constitute 48 percent whereas it accounts for only 27 percent in those over 60 years or more. LPA REPORTS UNIFIED WOMEN'S UNION LEADERSHIP
