VWP CC MEMBER VISITS BIEN HOA, URGES EMULATION DRIVE

[Text] Saigon (LPA July 4)--After having visited a number of factories in the Bien Hoa industrial area, Comrade Hoang Quoc Viet, member of the Central Committee of the Vietnam Workers Party and president of the Vietnam Federation of Trade Unions, Wednesday morning gave a talk to over 1,000 worker representatives.
