VIETNAMESE SHUFFLE 12/27/84
Big changes are reportedly on the way in the Vietnamese Foreign Ministry. Two vice-ministers are expected to leave soon to take up senior ambassadorial positions. One, Ha Van Lau — who 30 years

ago was a member of the Vietnamese team in negotiations with the French at Geneva — will be going to Paris. The other, Hoang Anh Tuan, will probably go to New Delhi. Their places in Hanoi are expected to be filled from the ranks of six assistant ministers.
