HOANG TRUONG MINH VISITS MOUNTAINOUS REGION

[Text] A work team led by Hoang Truong Minh, member of the VCP Central Committee and chairman of the National Assembly Nationalities Council, recently visited Dac Lac and Gia Lai-Cong Tum Provinces to conduct an economic survey and study guidelines for economic development in the mountainous region and for organizing the implementation of the movement for settled farming and settled life according to the method of combining agricultural and forestry.
