PROMINENT CATHOLIC PRIEST'S DEATH ANNOUNCED

[Text] The VFF Central Committee, the Committee for Solidarity of Patriotic Vietnamese Catholics [CSPVC], and the Hai Hung Provincial VFF Committee, with boundless grief, herewith announce that the Reverend Dominic Pham Quang Phuoc, member of the VFF Central Committee, acting president of the CSPVC, former deputy of the Fifth National Assembly, vice chairman of the Hai Hung Provincial VFF Committee, member of the Hai Hung Provincial People's Council, vice chairman of the World Catholic Church for Peace, and recipient of the Independence Order second class and the Resistance Order third class, has unexpectedly passed away following his return to the Hai Hung church after carrying out religious activities in many localities. Despite wholehearted care and treatment of various physicians, he succumbed to old age and numerous chronic illnesses at 1630 on 4 March 1984 at the Hai Hung Hospital. He was 70.

The Reverend Pham Quang Phuoc is now lying in state at the church of Hai Duong City, Hai Hung Province. Visits to the late reverend will begin and the burial service will be held at 1400 on 6 March at the church of Hai Duong City, Hai Hung Province.
