**General Song Hao on War Veterans Activities**

[Text] To make preparations for the 45th anniversary of the war invalids day, 27 July, Senior Lieutenant General Song Hao and Major General Huynh Dac Huong, respectively chairman and secretary general of the Vietnam War Veterans Association [VWVA], held a working session with the Ministry of Labor, War Invalids and Social Welfare recently.

Comrade Tran Dinh Hoan, minister of Labor, War Invalids and Social Welfare and leading cadres of departments warmly welcomed the VWVA delegation.

After exchanging views on issues of mutual concern, the Ministry of Labor, War Invalids and Social Welfare and the VWVA unanimously agreed to implement a number of major programs. They include the establishment of specialist teams to study and formulate long-term policies on helping wounded soldiers and families of fallen combatants to be submitted to the government, plans to uniformly renovate military cemeteries which is to be closely supervised, creating favorable conditions for the VWVA to resolve unemployment problem for families of war veterans, and wounded, sick and discharged soldiers in accordance with the Council of Ministers' decision No. 370. Efforts will be made to seek assistance from ministries and state agencies concerned to provide more jobs the unemployed to fight poverty.

Officials of the ministry and the VWVA also agreed that they will hold periodic meetings to inform each other on the results of their work and to discuss measures to carry out tasks in the days ahead.
