Tai Van Ta was born in 1938 in Ninh Binh province, Vietnam. He received his law degree at the University of Saigon in 1960, his Masters from the University of Virginia in 1964 and his PhD from the University of Virginia in 1965. He was a professor at the Saigon Law School from 1965-75 and a partner in private practice in South Vietnam during that same time until coming to the United States in 1975.

He is a 1985 graduate of the Harvard Law School. He is a research associate at Harvard and New York University Law Schools.

He is co-author of "The Laws of Southeast Asia", 1986; "The Le Code: Law in Traditional Vietnam, 1987"; "Investment Law in Vietnam", 1990; and author of "Vietnamese Tradition of Human Rights", 1988.
