At 0740H, Co A departed LZ Liz to conduct S & D operations in support of units in contact. Recon airlifted for C into 35715445. C/1-25 OPCCO to 2-35, conducted C1 north of contact via 727177, at 0928H, 23 lifted to Co B (-). Contact broken in the late afternoon, 1/2-35 returned with 2-4 Cav to LZ Liz for security. Recon OPCCO to 3/2-25, units extracted. Recon 3/2-35 and C/1-25 to conduct ambushes. All were in place at 2200H.</p>

0600: At 0600, Co B (-) 1st VC moved under intense mortar fire. Elements of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th VC companies of the 1st VC Bn, 1st VC regiment, 1st, 2nd and Recon platoon moved in to reinforce Co B (-). C/1-35 moved south and west to hit the enemy from the east flank. During the battle, CPT Waller was KIA, LT Chapman Co B VC took command and was later KIA, LT Krout then assumed command until replaced by CPT Lindsey in the PM. At 0630H, B/1-9 Coy placed C/1-35 to 2-25 Blues conducted a 3 mi wide sweep moving to the west, along the Song Tra Tay Valley. 1/1-25 and C/2-4 Coy (-) entered from the east, at 0615H. At 0630H, contact was broken by the enemy. Although several of the sweep resulted in 28 VC killed (20), 2 VC MIA, 108 VCS detained, 12 arms and 57mm RR and a 82mm mortar destroyed. At 1800H Co B extracted to perimeter, C/1-9 Coy. At 1800H, B/1-9 Coy (Mobile) moved to 2-25. Temporary extension 2 In N/S of Song Tra Tay Valley oriented east to the 85 M/S grid line. Friendly losses 6 MIA from Co B, 3 KIA and 12 MIA from Co B, 1 MIA from 3/2-9.
