Lt Farmer was a 2/9 Arty FO attached to C, 2/35th. He died on 05/29/67, but according to this note from Jim Lanning was actually wounded in the big fight on 5/20. Maybe you wish to add his name to your narrative—I am having this info recorded on Coffelt Database.

As I recall, Farmer deserved the Medal of Honor! Farmer, even after being severely wounded, joined again in the hand-to-hand Battle on 20 May, 1967. I was there, and asked for a DSC—I was very disappointed when I learned it had been downgraded to the Silver Star. (Signed) Jim Lanning, LTC(Ret) USA.
