Dear MG Moore,

As a former member of the 2d Battalion 35<sup>th</sup> Infantry, I am writing to you to seek some help with my ongoing project on the "Cacti" in Vietnam. I am a member of the 35<sup>th</sup> Infantry Association and have attended both of the reunions, first in Las Vegas and then this past year in DC. I served with Bravo Company from August of 1967 until I extended my tour and went to Saigon in July of 1968.

I started a website about the 35<sup>th</sup> Infantry this past September and have posted numerous Operational Reports and After Action Reports from the 2/35<sup>th</sup>, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Brigade Task Force and the 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division. I have obtained a number of the reports from the National Archives at College Park, MD and many have been donated by former Cacti who have visited my website (or through my prodding with e-mail messages). The Archives has searched for Quarterly reports from the 2/35<sup>th</sup> and has informed me that they do not have copies of such. Searches through the NTIS have also proven fruitless. If there is another place that I might look I would appreciate some advice in that area also. Before this next year is complete, I will obtain all of the Daily Journals from 1966 through 1970 when the Cacti returned home.

What I am looking for are those missing reports concerning the Cacti, whether they are Operations Reports, rosters, After Action Reports or other reports that you might believe to be of interest to the men of our unit. I am contacting you because there is a chance that you might have retained copies of these reports. If so, I and the members of the Association would greatly appreciate the chance to obtain copies so that they might be posted on the website for all to see.
