Jim: Received your letter and will give you what info I have.

I was ops sgt for the bn from Jan 65 to Dec 66. I prepared all the daily journals for the bn during our time in Nam. The journals were classified confidential so I don't have any of them. Stan Tyson (Bn XO, e-mail is cc) took these journals and wrote the after-action and/or quarterly combat reports. I don't know if he has any of them in his possession. He may respond to you.

The largest enemy contact the 2/35 had occurred in May 65 at LZ 10A (or 11A). B 2/35 and later A 1/35 (I think) killed over 300 NVA there. I saw many of the bodies a few days later where the NVA buried them. MAJ Tyson assumed command of the two companies during the battle and he may have more details. It is also documented in SLA Marshall's book "Battles in the Monsoons."

I hope this will help you a little. I can also give you names of other people who may help including the S3 at the time and other officers.

I will certainly check your website. Keep in touch.
