I am fast approaching a point that we need to concentrate on accuracy, as much as is remembered. I feel that in order to make this paper as good as we can get it, I would like to have the following, from whomever seems to be the best source:

1. Names of the Officers and their positions in the unit (CO, 1st Plt, etc) and the 1st Sgt of Co C, 1/35.
2. Confirmation that the 1st Sgt of B/ 2/35 was Harry Miller as Bisantz stated, or was he named Harris, as SMG Beauchamp remembered. Harris could have been the name of the B Co Senior Medic.
