2d BATTALION, 35th INFANTRY
(THE CACTI)

Organized 13 July 1916 in the Regular Army at Douglas, Arizona as Company B, 35th Infantry

Assigned 7 August 1918 to the 18th Division

(18th Division demobilized 14 February 1919 at Camp Travis, Texas)

Assigned 17 October 1922 to the Hawaiian Division

Relieved 26 August 1941 from assignment to the Hawaiian Division and assigned as an organic element of the 25th Infantry Division

Relieved 1 February 1957 from assignment to the 25th Infantry Division; concurrently, redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battle Group, 35th Infantry and inactivated in Hawaii

Assigned 19 February 1962 as an organic element of the 25th Infantry Division and activated in Hawaii (concurrently, organic elements constituted and activated in Hawaii)

Reorganized and redesignated 12 August 1963 as the 2d Battalion, 35th Infantry

Relieved 1 August 1967 from assignment to the 25th Infantry Division and assigned to the 4th CAMPAIGN PARTICIPATION CREDIT Infantry Division
