REMARKS:

He has 4 plts stationed one at each pass - usually 25 kilos away from the Border itself.

The Col is a graduate of the Thai Military Academy and the Army Staff College. He has attended a Counter Insurgency Course conducted at Clark AFB by U.S. Instructors. He hopes to attend the Advance Course at Ft. Benning.

His last assignment was in the Operations section at Border Police Headquarters in Bangkok.
