- 17 June : Co B found 1 hootch containing 450 lbs unpolished rice. Operation Futnam Paragon.
- 18 June : Co B rec'd 15 to 20 rds AK 250° 200m results 1 US WIA. Booby traps reported at LZ Terrace.
- 19 June : Co D at LZ Terrace took 60mm and small arms 25 to 30 rds AK. All 60mm were short of LZ Terrace. Co B(3rd Plt) found a 2 man fighting position. Recon found 450 lbs rice. Co D (3rd Plt) found 2 booby traps, E and W side of LZ Terrace.
- 20 June : Co D found 1 sleeping hootch and 1 bunker w/2½ ft overhead. Co B (2nd Plt) 3 employed small arms on 6 enemy resulting in 1 enemy KIA, 1 ruck, 1 9mm clip, 2 US WIA. Co B (2nd Plt) 0940 spotted estimated company of enemy, employed small arms, M-60, M-79, R/L enemy at 25m, 270° returned fire, no rounds unknown, G/S also expended. Contact continued through day. Also at 1630 hrs heavy again. At this time requested urgent dust off for Co B (2nd Plt). At this time 19 enemy KIA (NVA). Co B (3rd Plt) 1 enemy KIA and 1 Chieu Hoi. Co B (2nd Plt) 1 WIA enemy wearing green fatigues, have 8 AK's now, all pith helmets and ruck sacks, 30 to 50 rucks, 8 blood trails. Co A (2nd Plt) Chi Com grenade, 1 US WIA. Co B (3rd Plt) trip flare, small arms, results 1 enemy KIA and 1 enemy WIA. Co B (3rd Plt) another enemy KIA result claymore. - 17 June : Co B found 1 hootch containing 450 lbs unpolished rice. Operation Futnam Paragon.
- 18 June : Co B rec'd 15 to 20 rds AK 250° 200m results 1 US WIA. Booby traps reported at LZ Terrace.

- 23 June : LZ Niagara. Co B (2nd Plt) found 1 enemy KBA.
- 24 June : Co B (3rd Plt) 1 enemy under small arms fire, results 2 KIA. Co C (2nd Plt) found 2 hootches, 450 lbs of rice.
- 25 June : Co B (2nd Plt) found 1 hootch. Co D (2nd Plt) contact w/2 enemy, 100m, neg findings, small arms, 1 US KIA, 2 WIA. Co B (3rd Plt) contact w/1 enemy, 1 WIA NVA.
- 26 June : No report.
- 27 June : RECON found unfinished hootch and 6 hootches, also found 2 bunkers. Co B found 4 bunkers.
- 28 June : Search and clear AO, 2 contacts. Co D (3rd Plt) at LZ Terrace, neg damage, and 1 contact when RECON rec'd sniper fire from a great distance.
- 29 June : Co A (2nd Plt) spotted 2 enemy, small arms employed. Co C (1st Plt) employed claymore, results 1 enemy KIA and second enemy KIA by small arms.
- 30 June : Trails and bunkers were found today by Co A and RECON at separate locations.

JULY

- 1 July : No report.
- 2 July : LZ Niagara. RECON found a footbridge 2 ft wide, 50 to 60 ft long, made of vines and poles. RECON 1110, 1 enemy jumped up and opened fire with M-16, returned fire 50m, due E, black PJ's, Ho Chi Minh sandals, no headgear or ruck. Co A (2nd Plt) trail 18 in wide, E to W. Co D (3rd Plt) at LZ Terrace, 500m, 5 to 10 rds, AK, employed small arms. PS Co D security LZ Niagara and LZ Terrace.
