1. Suggest we shoot for initial reports for period ending June 30 repeat June 30, 1963 in format suggested reference B with modification proposed by mission which Nestel prepared review with you. Appreciate fact that some info. difficult or impossible to obtain. Guidelines intended to provide work sheet for needed report but to be modified as necessary.

2. Realize that certain portions cited reference A (Commodity Imports etc.) not CI. However, they were included because (A) Need to better information here; (B) their direct impact on CI; (C) desire consolidate general reporting program to include in one series of reports, activities which are related and can be reported similar fashion; and (D) plan to eliminate overlapping or duplicating reports by concentrating on one comprehensive report system.

3. Plan to have Nestel leave few days after Boyd's return. Nestel able discuss and adjust both content and form proposed reporting directive. Request ETA on Boyd which presume on or before June 15.

4. Since latest available data still needed June 20 or sooner for use in congressional presentation, would appreciate transmittal info. generally as outlined in ref. B in whatever form now prepared in mission.

5. Ref. A made reference to TOAID 2150. Believe TOAID 2051 or 2156 intended, if assumption correct, reply contained AIDTO 2389.
