I. SITUATION

A. Enemy

The loss of almost 200 strategic hamlets to the Viet Cong through lack of support from the Provincial Government has been the dominant factor in Long An. The Viet Cong seized the initiative in these neglected hamlets, creating the present situation in which an estimated 25% of the people actively support or are in sympathy with the enemy; another 25% are bound to the Government through family or employment and the remaining 50% are indifferent to the war, caring little for victory by either side.

Aggressive, daily propaganda efforts by the Viet Cong political cadres have capitalized on the dissatisfaction of the hamlet people. The chief complaints of the hamlet residents are the failure of the Government to provide protection against the VC and the graft and favoritism by local officials.

B. Friendly

An increased effort has been ordered in Long An. A military clear and hold operation began on 15 January with one battalion. Additional operations are planned for succeeding months. Only about 30 New Rural Life Hamlets remain under Government control. The provincial technical services are prevented from carrying out their respective functions because of the poor security situation. Assistance to the hamlets by the technical services is limited to these thirty hamlets and areas immediately adjacent to the district capitals.

II. MISSION

To gain the loyalty and support of the rural people by (a) insuring that the services of all provincial technical agencies reach the hamlet; (b) supporting the military pacification effort to the maximum by concentrating major efforts in clear and hold area.

III. PLAN

A. Concept of Operations

To employ the Provincial Technical Services as weapons in the battle for the loyalty of the people. The overall concept includes:

- (a) A survey of the hamlets to determine defensive requirements, material needs, and mandatory political changes.
- (b) A military operation designed to reinforce the hamlet and prevent overt VC activity.
- (c) Implementation, by each technical division, of the detailed plan included herein as an attachment. Priority 1 to Ap Tan Sinh (ATS) in Clear & Hold (C&H) area.
- (d) Full information and psychological warfare coverage of all aspects of the program.
