Graduated from University of Massachusetts

1925-26 : Harvard (Masters)

Biology Teacher

Principal of a school in MA.

1942: WW II: OSS, based in London, parachuted a number of times in occupied France

1948-1953: Marshall Plan - USOM to France (Controller's Division as Chief Field Investigator and later Defense Requirements Division as Defense Production Analyst)

1954-1958: French Machine Tool Company, Manurhin, France

1958-1961: USOM Djakarta. Controller's Office.

1961-1965: Saigon. Controller's Office. 1962 Rural Affairs. 1964 Chieu Hoi.

1965-1969: Luang Prabang, Laos - USAID Area Coordinator for northern provinces of Laos

1969-1984: *Retired in his beloved France...Wonderful Father, Grandfather, storyteller and gardener!!!*
