Dear Rufe,

"The Box" is ready to ship. It is just a matter of getting it into the hands of Col. Mike Radke, -and it will be on its way. Our phone has been out for days due to typhoon, ..so maybe tomorrow or next day.

Am enclosing copy of list of contents. Your mss is in envelope 22 along with other touchy messages. I put a (●) on envelopes 10 and 19 thru 22 as items you would want to see, but obviously there are others.

The Chicu Hoi material is quite scattered. There doesn't seem to be anything that identifies it specifically with Bo. Am under impression that Chicu Hoi was Bo's "baby"-- adapting the returnee program used in Philippines-- or am I wrong?

The biodata on Bui Diem is somewhat scanty, stopping short of his accomplishments. Maybe you could add? And- who the devil was horseblanket? I think I identify Moncreif but not sure. There are memos to & from the Carabao not identified, if you want to add that info., -up to you.

I doubt whether Ed would feel like looking at any of the Team material so didn't even suggest it, but he might get a kick out of hearing of it from you.

The loss of Hank is a real blow. Ever since Pat wrote that he was home from hospital and identified the problem, Claring and I have sweated it out right along with them, almost step by step. So many of the old friends have followed Bo. I'm so glad Ed is hanging in there.

Re Rural Affairs, some of the former CDOs brought a John (Jack) D. Donahue out for a get-together with other UN "veterans" of USOM. He said he had worked for you in Saigon, was about 23 then, and had heard about Lansdale and Bohannon. He is now with Allied Corporation, his card sez Manager, Security Services. He came as fore-runner for his Boss, setting up appointments, then as Boss arrived moved on to Singapore. His address is P.O. Box 2245R, Morristown, New Jersey 07960. He sent you his regards.

We see quite a few of the CDOs quite often. Lately they meet here at least once a week. Have organized to do Rural Dev. work in RP, calling themselves "Innovative Services Specialists Development, Inc" !!! (ISSD) with the blessings of AJD.

I am delighted that you are interested in the material, and hope you will permit a copy, ~~and~~ even watered down, of your mss to be included. As mentioned before I feel that in fairness to you and the Team, the in-fighting should be included for the sake of serious researchers. Being blocked by people who did not understand the concepts or appreciate what you were trying to accomplish, for selfish reasons or whatever, made a big difference.

I'm sorry Mark asked me to burn his material, which I did reluctantly. He said his remarks were perhaps hasty, but I don't think they were.

You asked when Bo and I went over to Saigon. We arrived in the Philippines about September of 62. Bo was under contract to Rand to do a paper on the Huks, - a documented dissertation. He got busy making arrangements for access to the classified material, outdated but not yet de-classified, scattered all over the place, and I had a crew to photograph the documents, so we had a good start.

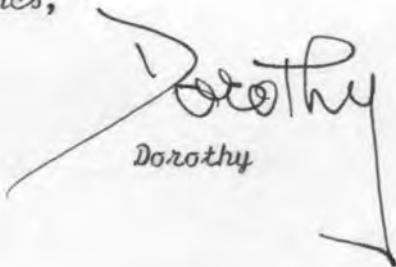
About November 62 you sent out an SOS, and Bo went to Saigon to take a looksee. Decided that was more interesting and worth while than digging into the Huk business personally. Arranged for a Fil. historian to do the writing while I continued to gather material. He started (Bo) commuting Mla/Saigon. But the writer was a flop. He did not know the meaning of "documented" and didnt bother with facts. So Bo regretfully cancelled his contract w/ Rand and returned the money they had advanced. This about Jan or Feb 63. Meanwhile he had me riding herd on a re-publication of the Constabulary Manual of 1915 which he had been able to get a copy of from Elarth. When that was finished and bound and the original returned to Elarth, I joined Bo in Saigon. (See Ltr to Felix Aug 63 env. 21)

Bo meanwhile was commuting, and I think stayed at the ECCOT compound in Cholon. I arrived just when you and Barbara ~~mmmm~~ had left for a vacation for 2 weeks or so, so we baby-sat your house. When you returned we stayed in the Conein "doll house" for a while, then moved to a nice little house in the ECCOT compound. Celebrated our 25th Anniversary there in August 63. Martial law curfew fouled that up, so we had to change plans fast and start the celebration at 4 so folks could get home ~~mm~~ before curfew, otherwise stay all night. The Fil group put on quite a show, with the tinikling and dance program everyone enjoyed. Instead of a cocktail party, evryone in the compound was invited for supper and party which (at club) lasted till the wee small hours. Some outsiders stayed overnight.

I left for DC & mother Bohannan about the 29th or 30th of September (?) just before the coup. Temples were being raided, and early in the morning you could hear trumpets sending messages from one temple to another, like cocks crowing, distant then getting closer and closer, then passing on beyond you. It was eerie. I should have taped it, at 4am.

Enough. More rain. Another typhoon heading in.

Whether or not this material should go to the archives at Hoover Institute I will leave in your hands. As my surrogate please feel free to withhold or destroy whatever you feel should be withheld or destroyed.

This box, identified as "85/01 : Bohannon/Vietnam " contains 25 envelopes and/or folders, the bulk of which dates from 1963-66. A fairly detailed listing is enclosed in the box.

Rufus Phillips, as Assistant Director of Rural Affairs, USOM, was Bo's immediate Boss during much of this time. A recent letter from Rufc says he is gathering notes for a book on Rural Affairs, and he would like very much to have a look at Bo's Vietnam stuff before it is sent on to Hoover, -- for the memories as well as to get his own records straight.

So, I would like to request that he be given the opportunity to go through the material, and perhaps he could help with the screening.

To Whom It May Concern:

Lt.Col. Charles Ted Rutledge Bohannon (nb. Ted, not Theodore) agreed before his death in 1982 to send his papers to the archives at Hoover Institution. (Attr. Charles G. Palm, Archivist. Hoover Institution, Stanford, Calif. 94305)

This box, identified as " 85/01: Bohannon/Vietnam" contains Bohannon papers in 25 envelopes and/or folders, the bulk of which dates from 1963 to 1966. A fairly detailed listing is attached.

Except for the photos included, the contents of this box has been treated as highly classified material, buried in a hidden safe for years. Much is more than 20 years old and therefore could probably be considered de-classified. Insurgency and the Cold War however have not gone out of style, so maybe some of the papers should maintain their classification. Some should probably be withheld, and some destroyed.

My reluctance to send these papers directly to Hoover was solved when Gen. Dick Stilwell kindly offered to be my surrogate, and asked that the material be sent to him for review. This I am herewith so doing.

Rufus C. Phillips, as Assistant Director of Rural Affairs, USOM, was Bo's immediate Boss during much of this time. I would like to ask that he be given the opportunity to look over the material before it is sent to Hoover. He could perhaps assist in the screening.

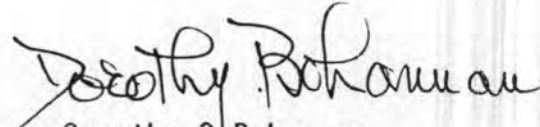

Envelope #22 contains personal communications from Phillips (in DC.) to Bohannon (in Saigon) during trying times. I think he should have them. I marked thusly (●) those envelopes I thought he would especially want to see, but there may be others as well. I will send him a copy of the listing.

For the Record: Bohannon signed himself variously, depending on the addressee and the occasion. Besides Bo, CTRB, ctrb; also El Lobo, Lobo, Sloba (from his call signal w/ the 32nd Div); also TM or Tandang Malupit which is Tagalog for "mean Old Man"; and in one paper for Rand, Bo used the nom de plume of J.M. Carrier.

I hope the attached listing will be helpful.
