GALLO, NICOLAS G. [REDACTED] SPECIALIST FOUR United States Army Company C,
2d Battalion (Airmobile) 5th Cavalry

Awarded: Army Commendation Medal with "V" Device

Dates of Action: 19 June to 21 June 1970


Theater: Republic of Vietnam

Authority: By direction of the Secretary of the Army, under the provisions of
Army Regulation 672-5-1.

Reason: Specialist Four Gallo distinguished himself by heroism in sustained
combat operations against a hostile force in the Kingdom of Cambodia
from 19 June to 21 June 1970. He pursued the enemy with aggressive
military tactics, neutralizing and defeating him whenever contact
could be made. His heroic and valiant actions were often characterized
by unselfishly exposing himself to hostile fire under the adverse conditions
inherent in a combat environment. He has contributed materially
to the successful accomplishment of the United States' mission in the
Kingdom of Cambodia. His display of personal bravery and devotion to
duty is in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service,
and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States
Army.
