AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL FOR HEROISM

1. TC 320. The following AWARD is announced.

MAYNARD, MICHAEL M. 05334814 (SSAN: NOT AVAILABLE) SECOND LIEUTENANT INFANTRY  
United States Army Battery A, 1st Battalion, 77th Artillery

Awarded: Bronze Star Medal with "V" Device

Date action: 9 March 1968

Theater: Republic of Vietnam


Reason: For heroism, not involving participation in aerial flight, in connection with military operations against a hostile force in the Republic of Vietnam. Second Lieutenant Maynard distinguished himself by exceptionally valorous action on 9 March 1968, while serving as a forward observer for Company G, 2nd Battalion, 5th Cavalry during a combat mission near Pho Trach, Republic of Vietnam. When his unit became heavily engaged with a large enemy force, Lieutenant Maynard exposed himself to the hostile fire as he moved from position to position in order to direct and adjust accurate suppressive fire on the insurgent's positions. His display of personal bravery and devotion to duty is in keeping with the highest traditions of the military service, and reflects great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army.
