Reason: For heroism, the individual participated in aerial flight, in connection with ground operations against a hostile force in the Republic of Vietnam. Sergeant David E. Spradler distinguished himself by valorous action on 3 January 1972. With complete disregard for his own safety, he courageously took actions which were inspirational to the other members of his unit and were instrumental in the successful completion of the mission. His display of personal bravery and devotion to duty is a credit to the military service, and reflects credit on himself, his unit and the United States Army.

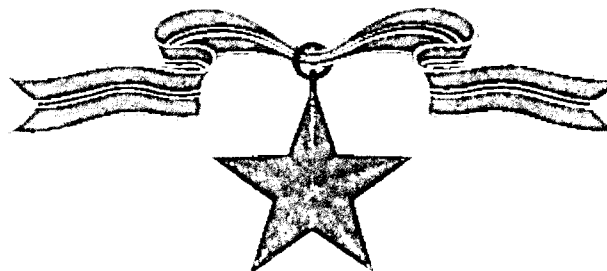
