The 2d Battalion (Airmobile) 5th Cavalry moves as part of the First Cavalry Division (Airmobile) to new base areas in III Corps Tactical Zone on or about 9 November. Battalion displaces in two echelons. The tactical echelon includes units and equipment required for normal combat operations. The rear echelon will consist of combat non-essential equipment and supplies. Command guidance stipulates that individual and bulk loads should be "lean" to efficiently utilize aircraft space. Commanders will begin making necessary preparations to include type and amount of personal and company equipment which will be required in the tactical echelon. Units are to arrive at destination ready for immediate commitment into a combat situation. Keeping the above stated guidance in mind, units should take spare parts and essential supplies to support operations for a 10 day period. All equipment, vehicles, and supplies should be organized by priority. These priorities will be the basis for requesting and assigning aircraft spaces.
