Still working - take a look at March and April 1969.

But - I need some information.

On picture #5, you identify the person as Bob Pegeus - I think. How do you spell his last name? Also, you ID him as a supervisor at "Rauland." Is that right?

PFC Robert Pegues (According to the erroneous April 9 Morning Report). Yes, he was a Supervisor at Rauland Corporation in Chicago before becoming a Trooper.

On #7, the third person you ID as "Groover." Is that spelling correct?

That was his nickname. I thought his real name was Gaylord Russell, but that's not right, it may have been Gary Turner, but I really don't know.

Your pix in Okinawa - when did you get hit? April 6th? Can you tell us the story of how you got hit? Go back to the States? Tell us more!!!

I didn't get hit, I hit the ground jumping from a chopper when the Company CA'd into the area that was to become LZ Ike on or about April 20 or 22. I was on point that day, first bird, first lift. The guy that went out the other door broke both legs, I think. I got sent to Camp Kui, Okinawa for orthopedic surgery and stayed on the Rock until August. Then the Doc's decided that I'd not be coming off profile (No service in RVN or Korea). I spent the next year at Ft. Leonard Wood. I wouldn't feel bad if you didn't post that pic unless you think there is a good reason to post it.

Anyway - we're getting there. Thanx.




