
PS. I hope the enclosed CD plays on your computer.

Slide Show Instructions.


On the CD is a 3 minute slide show I put together from the pictures I took on my trip to visit you and Martha.

If you want to (try) to watch it -- here's what might work.
(Not all computers act the same way... so this might not work)

1. Put the CD in the computer and slide the drawer closed.
2. Wait about 30 seconds for the computer to recognize the CD is there.
3. Go to the **My Computer** icon on your screen and **left-double-click** it.
4. With My Computer open, look for the disk drive letter (maybe D: maybe E:) where the CD is and **left-double-click** it.



Hopefully, your screen looks something like this (below).



Now we've got to tell the **Microsoft PowerPoint Viewer** program which slide show to play.

6. Hopefully, the **Look In:** box shows your CD drive already, (if not, you'll have to use the little drop-down arrow and find it.)

If (when) the **Look In:** box shows your CD drive, below it you should see an Icon with a file name "Visit with Dick & Martha.ppt".

Turn up your speaker volume a little, and **left-double-click** Visit with Dick & Martha.ppt
