CAMBODIA'S NEW CABINET LIST

PHNOM PENH, Oct 29 (Reuter) - This is Cambodia's new cabinet line-up approved by parliament on Friday, together with the holders' party affiliations.

Co-ministers were appointed for the defence and for the interior and national security portfolios.

In some cases, only a secretary of state -- a position senior to deputy minister -- has so far been named.

Defence: General Tea BANH (CPP) and Tea CHAMPAT (FUNCINPEC)

Public Works and Transport: Ing KIETH (FUNCINPEC)

Finance and Economy: Sam RAINSY (FUNCINPEC)

Justice: Chem SNGUON (CPP)

Health: Chhea THAIN (CPP)

Agriculture, Forests and Fishery: Kong Som OL (CPP)

Tourism: Veng SIRIVUDH (FUNCINPEC), secretary of state

Religion and Cults: Hean VANRATH (CPP), secretary of state

(FUNCINPEC is the French acronym for the National United Front for an Independent, Neutral, Peaceful and Cooperative Cambodia. The CPP is the formerly communist Cambodian People's Party and the BLDP the Buddhist Liberal Democratic Party.)
