#### FREE ZONE MARKS INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

[Text] Sam Neua--A grand meeting has been held in the Laotian liberated areas to mark International Women's Day (March 8), under the sponsorship of the Patriotic Laotian Women's Federation. Present were Mme Khampheng Boupha, member of the Central Committee of the Laotian Patriotic Front, and chairman of the Patriotic Laotian Women's Federation; and more than 400 cadres, workers, and public servants.

Prince Souphanouvong, chairman, Sithon Kommadam, vice-chairman of the Central Committee of the Laotian Patriotic Front, phoun sipaseuth, member of the L.O.F.C.C. and representative of the Supreme Command of the Laotian Peoples Liberation Army, and Khamsouk Keola, representative of the Patriotic Neutralist Forces, also attended.

Mme Khampheng Boupha delivered a speech summing up the history of the International Women's Day, and highlighting the big victories recorded by the Laotian people and women in the present stage of the Laotian people's resistance to the U.S. aggressors, for national salvation, and called on them to resolutely carry on with the fight till final victory. She expressed sincere thanks to women in the world for their sympathy and support to the Laotian people and women in their anti-U.S. resistance. Addressing the meeting, Prince Souphanouvong warmly hailed the Laotian women's achievements in production, fighting and other activities, and called on them to unite closely with the men in overcoming all difficulties and accomplishing their tasks of defeating the U.S. special war and bringing the Laotian revolution to a new state. The meeting passed a resolution to be sent to the Central Committee of the Laotian Patriotic Front, expressing Laotian women's iron-clad will to defeat the U.S. aggressors and their henchmen, and to bring peace, independence, neutrality, democracy, unity, and prosperity to Laos.
