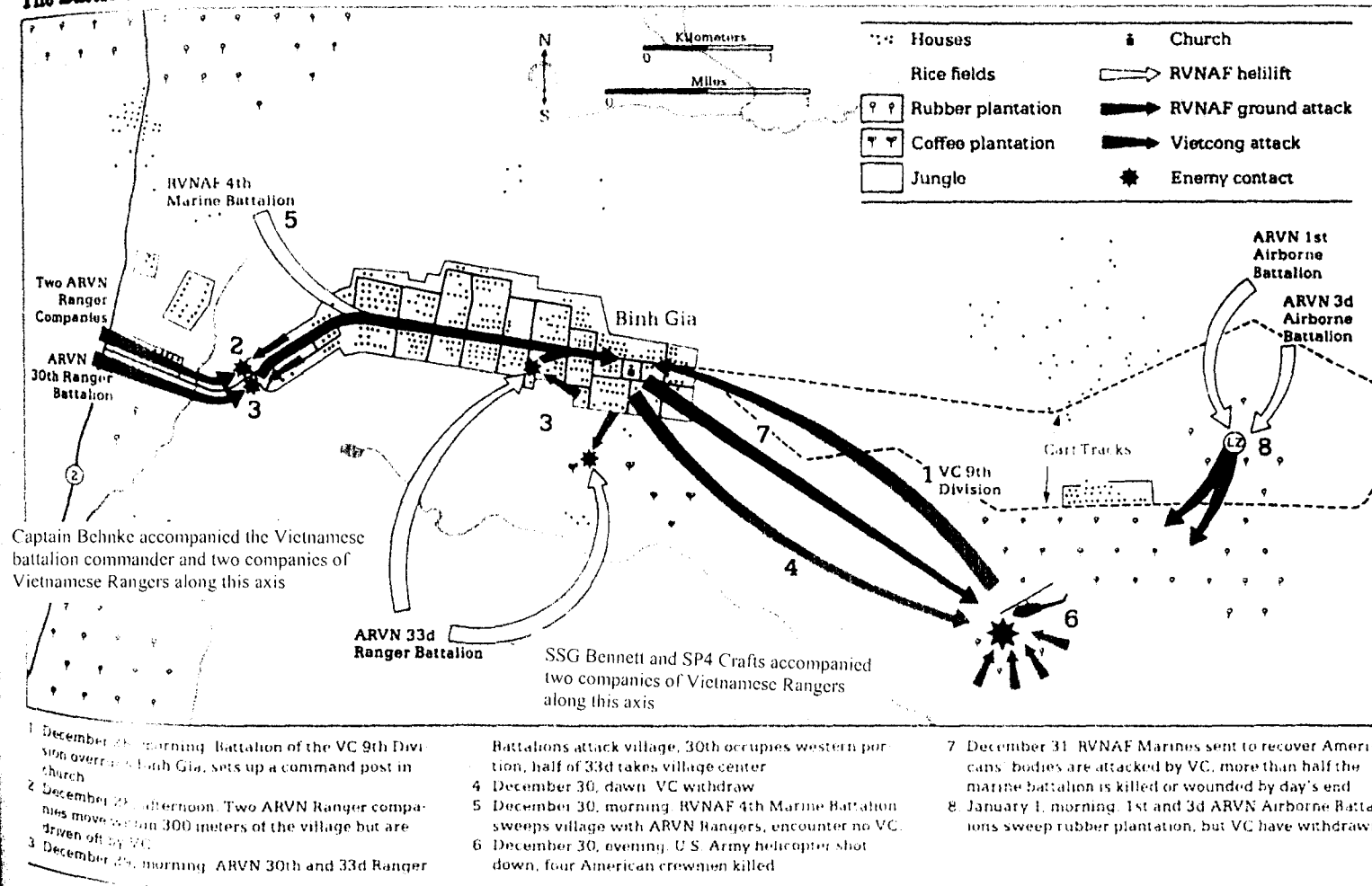
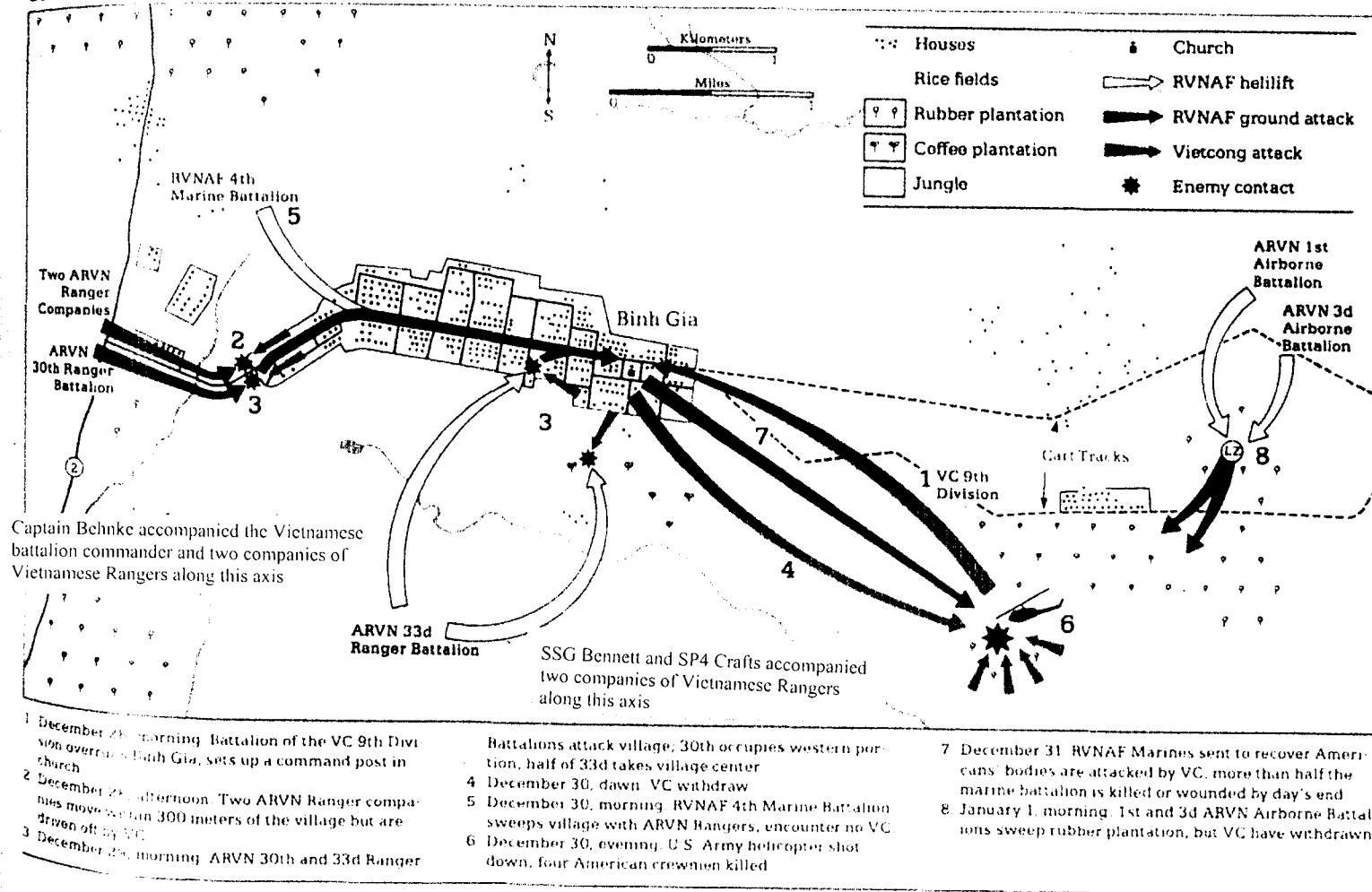

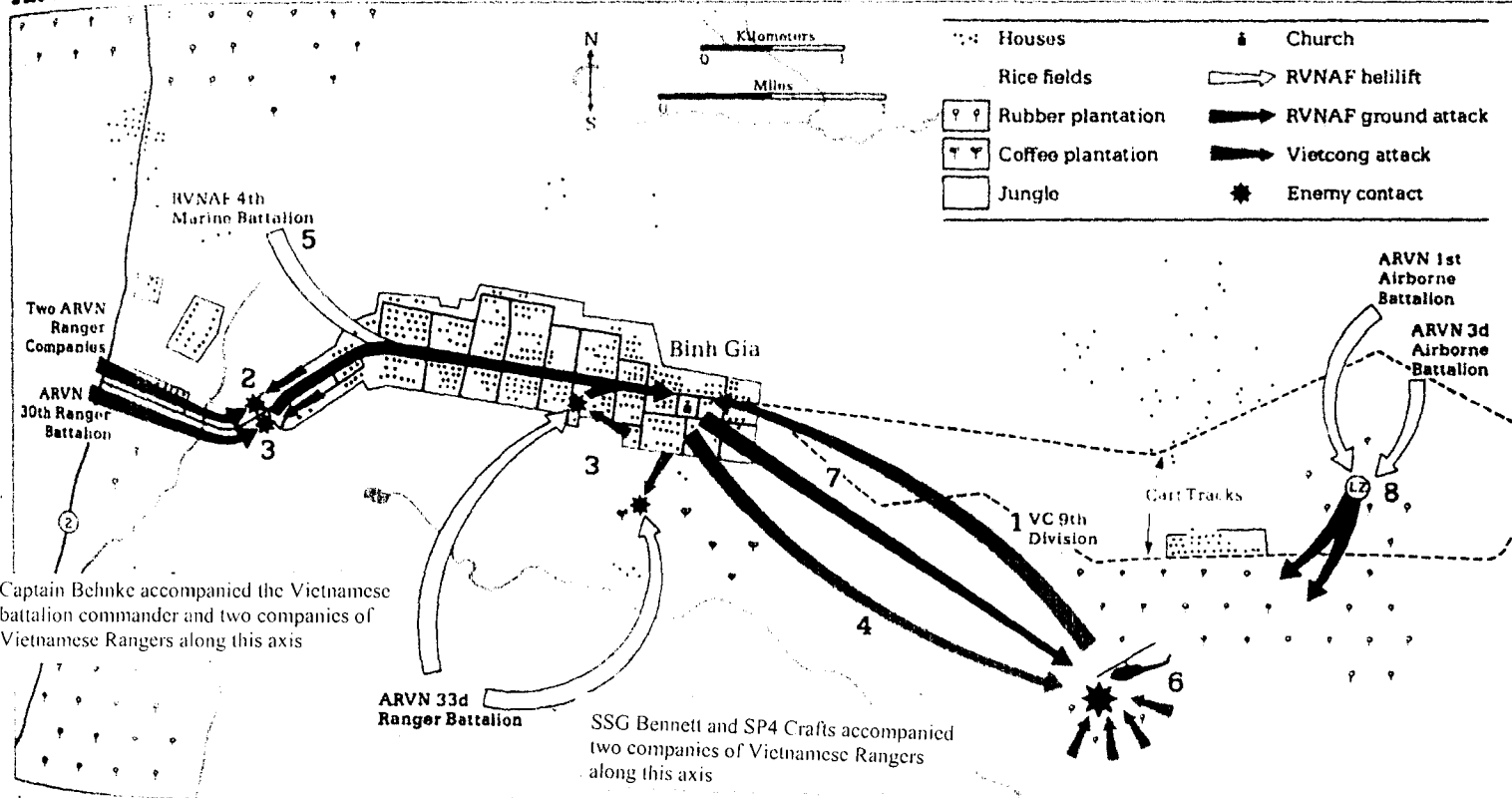

The Battle of Binh Gia



- 1 December 28, morning. Battalion of the VC 9th Division overtook Binh Gia, sets up a command post in church
- 2 December 28, afternoon. Two ARVN Ranger companies move within 300 meters of the village but are driven off by VC.
- 3 December 29, morning. ARVN 30th and 33d Ranger

- Battalions attack village, 30th occupies western portion, half of 33d takes village center
- 4 December 30, dawn. VC withdraw
- 5 December 30, morning. RVNAF 4th Marine Battalion sweeps village with ARVN Rangers, encounter no VC.
- 6 December 30, evening. U.S. Army helicopter shot down, four American crewmen killed

- 7 December 31. RVNAF Marines sent to recover Americans' bodies are attacked by VC, more than half the marine battalion is killed or wounded by day's end
- 8 January 1, morning. 1st and 3d ARVN Airborne Battalions sweep rubber plantation, but VC have withdrawn
