

- ✓ 1. RANCH HAND insignia on door of barracks at Da Nang
- ✓ 2. Smokey Bear forest service poster modified to RANCH HAND motto
- ✓ 3. UC-123B...note the red visual aid stripe on top of wing
- ✓ 4. Two UC-123s in "piggy-back" formation. Note the wing and tail booms. The yellow-barred insignia on the side indicates they are on a crop mission.
5. Overhead shot of UC-123 with all nozzles spraying
- ✓ 6. UC-123 just at bottom of valley, starting pull-up in treetops.
- ✓ 7. Flight of spray birds on target. Note bomb craters and discoloration of previous spray on vegetation tops.
- ✓ 8. Herbicide being sucked from drums on ARVN trucks. Note Orange stripe on barrels...its dreaded "Agent Orange"
- ✓ 9. Note lack of special protective gear on personnel
- ✓ 10. Same
- ✓ 11. Herbicide storage tanks and pump system at Da Nang. Blue stripe on the F6 trailers means they hold "Blue," i.e., Cacodylic Acid herbicide
12. RANCH non-commissioned officer running the pump system for Orange
13. Note the lack of protection to bare skin from the "deadly" chemical
14. Note the empty barrels of Orange (or full?) scattered around, and stains on the ground from spills.
- ✓ 15. Filling the aircraft herbicide tank. This crewman does wear gloves, but he has no protection on arms and face, or a breathing device in this enclosed space.
- ✓ 16. This is a flight mechanic's console, just behind the 1,000-gallon spray tank. The chain is to hold the armored box in place.
- ✓ 17. On the flightline at Da Nang. Note the wing and tail booms with their nozzles very obvious. The can was hung under nozzles that didn't seat properly, to keep them from dripping on the ramp, not because it was considered hazardous, but to keep from making a mess on the ramp.
18. Morning briefing prior to take-off on a mission from Bien Hoa
- ✓ 19. Results of VC rocket attack on a RANCH HAND trailer house at Bien Hoa
- ✓ 20. RANCH HAND field grade quarters after the Tet attack, February 1968
21. "Burn" stripes in vegetation reveal where the formation didn't overlap properly.
- ✓ 22. Coastal delta area in IV Corps shows the stark effect of defoliation, as contrasted to the tree lines which were missed between runs.
23. Forest which has been partially defoliated, opening up trails to view.
- ✓ 24. Another view of forest with a "burn" in right side of picture.

NOTE: I have several much better contrasted "burn" versus virgin forest, and a good shot of the stark trees of a defoliated rubber plantation.
